Sermon Starters

ARE YOU READY? Matthew 24:42-44

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Quite often, as we study the scriptures, we come across phrases that teach important facts.
- 2. Likewise, we find words that call our minds to certain thoughts.
 - A. In the Bible, we find the word "ready" used numerous times in regard to a variety of things.
 - B. In this lesson, we are going to examine some of the texts wherein we find this word.
 - 1. As we do this, let us ask ourselves, are we ready to comply with the thoughts that are found therein?

BODY:

1. PETER CLAIMED TO BE READY TO GO WHERE HE WAS LED

- A. Luke 22:33
 - 1. Wherever he was led he claimed he was ready to go.
- B. However, as we know, he was not ready.
 - 1. It was just that he thought he was.
 - 2. It was not long after this promise that Peter denied the Lord Matthew 26:69, 70.
- C. We should be ready to go with the Lord wherever He leads us Matthew 16:24.
 - 1. Our following Him should be like a soldier under sealed orders.
 - A. The question of obedience has been settled before the orders are opened.

2. PETER WAS READY TO GIVE AN ANSWER

- A. 1 Peter 3:15
 - 1. Each of us needs to be ready to do just as Peter said.
 - A. There is no excuse for a Christian that cannot give an answer for his beliefs.
- B. It will take study of the Word to be able to do this, but are we not told to study? 2 Timothy 2:15.
- C. To be able to "always give an answer" we need to have the right disposition of heart.
 - 1. It is easily realized that a person might win a discussion, but while he is doing so he might lose a soul.
 - 2. As we give an answer, we need to do so with the type of love for the lost that Jesus would want us to have.
 - 3. Instead of winning the discussion at all cost, let us win the soul Proverbs 11:30.

3. PAUL WAS READY TO PREACH THE GOSPEL

- A. Romans 1:15
- B. It is plain to see that he was ready to preach the gospel Romans 1:16.
- C. Because he was not ashamed of the gospel, he was ready to proclaim it as he should.
- D. These same reasons should motivate each of us to be ready to preach the gospel.

4. PAUL GAVE INSTRUCTION CONCERNING BEING READY TO ALL GOOD WORKS

- A. Titus 3:1
 - 1. In regards to good works, we need to be ready to see that they get done Galatians 6:10.
 - A. We should be ready to do it ourselves, and not wish it off on somebody else.
- B. Works, according to James, are the fruits of faith, as we show our faith by our works James 2:18.
- C. Each of us needs to be ready to show our faith through the good works that we perform, and as such glorify God Matthew 5:16.
- D. We must be careful to not grow "weary in well doing" Galatians 6:9; 2 Thessalonians 3:13.

5. PAUL WAS READY TO DIE FOR THE NAME OF JESUS

- A. Acts 21:13
- B. This statement was correct, he later died for Jesus.
- C. As we think of what Jesus must have meant to Paul, does He mean that much to us?
 - We have not been, as of yet, asked to die for Jesus.
 - A. We have only been asked to live for Him.
 - 1. Are we ready to do so as He asks?

6. JESUS COMMANDS US TO BE READY FOR HIS RETURN

- A. Matthew 24:42-44
- B. The tragedy of the foolish virgins of Matthew 25 was that they were not prepared for the coming of the bridegroom.
 - Likewise, the tragedy for countless souls will be their failure to prepare for the coming of Jesus.
 - A. We must know that this preparation does not come accidentally.
 - 1. We must make it on purpose.
 - 2. We do this by obeying the gospel.
